



- Recollection of Imam about prayers




Imam was lively, he was outstanding in **sports** and his **studies**. He attended a religious school where he learnt Quran and soon became famous for memorising religious and classical poetry.




Imam went to Qom and it was there that he studied Islamic law, jurisprudence, philosophy, literature and poetry. After completing his studies he began teaching in Qom.






In 1962, he protested against the Shah of Iran. He organised the religious scholars and together with them, strongly opposed Shah and his plans. He was sent to prison in 1963 and then thrown out of the country (exile).



He was deported to **Turkey** where he lived for a year before moving his base to **Najaf**. In his **14 years of exile**, he reasoned on a theory called **wilayat-al-faqih**, which stated how a true Islamic state should be led by a capable and just jurist (faqih) in the absence of Imam Mahdi (a.s).








Imam's growing popularity in Iraq and Iran forced the Iraqi government to deport him to Paris in France. Meanwhile, the mass protest against the Iranian government eventually caused the Shah to flee the country.

Therefore is the founder of the Islamic Republic of Iran and the leader of the 1979 Iranian Revolution which saw the overthrow of the King of Iran (Shah)









Iran-Iraq war lasted 8 years. During his time, Iran-Iraq war lasted 8 years.


Dress code for men and women was introduced, Western movies and alcohol, were banned.


Education was reformed.



















During the last month of Imam's life, he was ill and in need of increased supervision. During the nights, a soldier would sleep just outside the door of Imam's room. Once I asked that soldier whether he had any recollections of Imam from the period when he used to watch over him.

The soldier narrates: "Imam would normally wake up 2 hours before the time of the Fajr prayer. One night I heard Imam crying loudly. I also started crying. When Imam came out of his room in order to refresh his wudhu, he noticed me and said, "Oh soldier, value your youth and worship God. The pleasure of worship is in youth. When you get old, your heart will want to worship, but you will not have the health and strength to do so."
