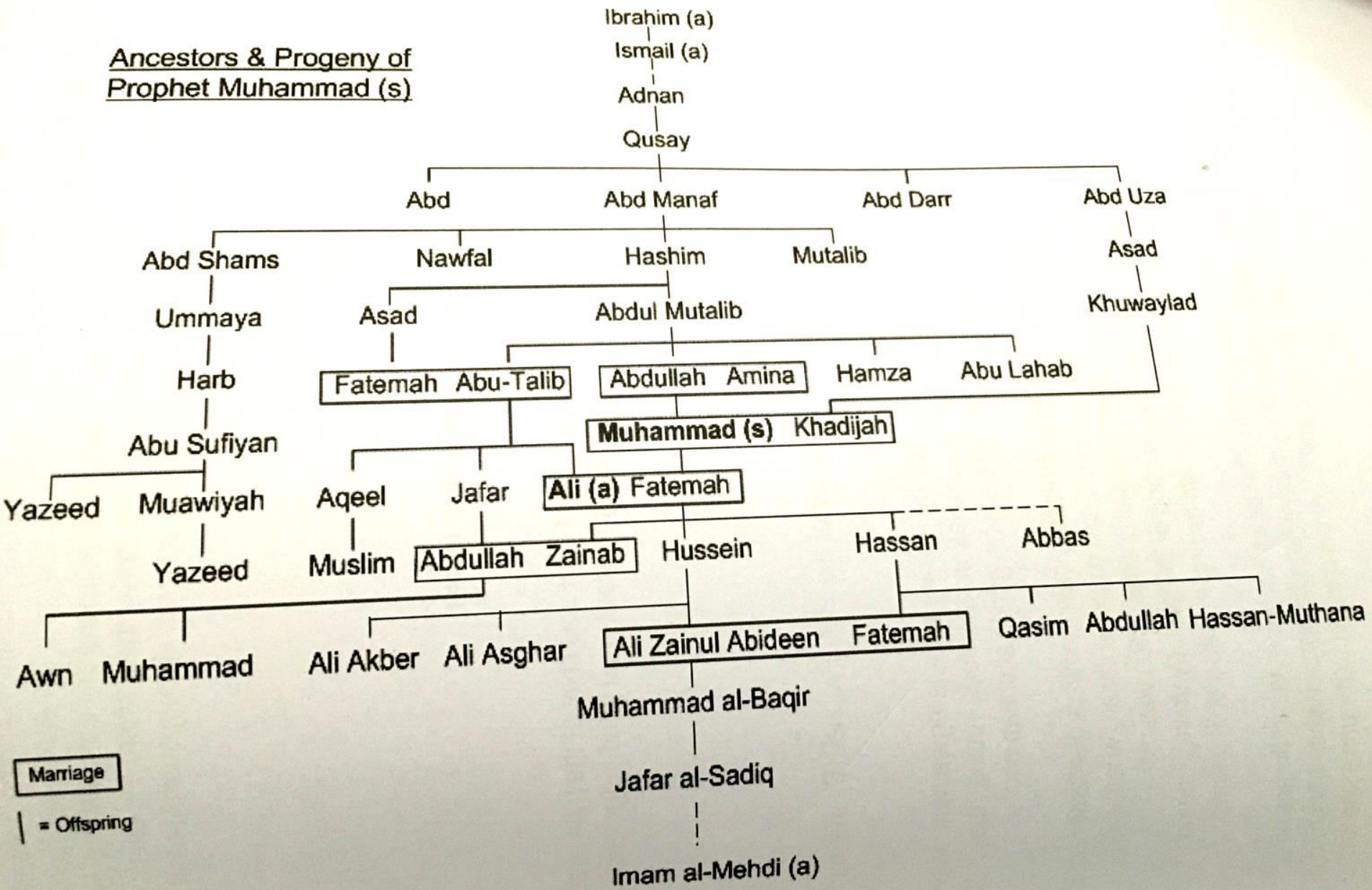

- He was in charge of the keys to Kaa'ba
- He made Daar un Nadwa
- He fed and gave water to the people on pilgrim to Kaa'ba
- He died in Mecca in 480 AD

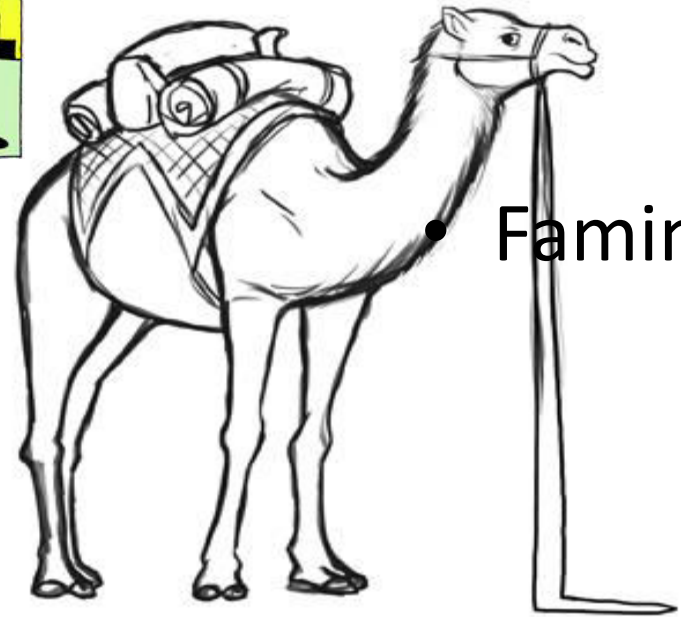
# Daar un Nadwa

- Hashim was the son of \_\_\_\_\_

- He had a twin brother called \_\_\_\_\_
- At the time there was a practice of the Arabs called IHTIFAAD, when members of a family could not earn enough to feed themselves, they would leave Mecca and go to the desert, where they would live in a tent till they dies of hunger or thirst.
