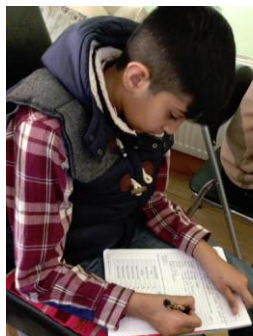

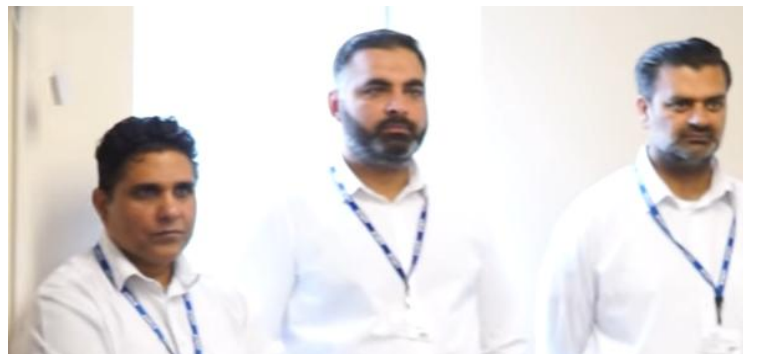

## Our Team

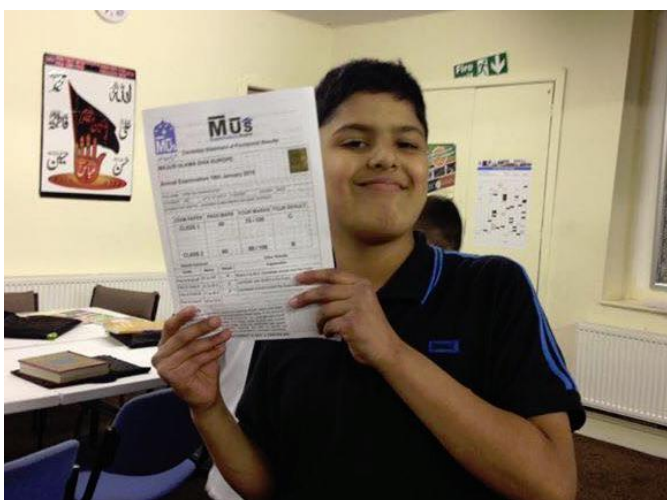

After successful completion of the books, parents are required to register their children online with the MUS examination board. 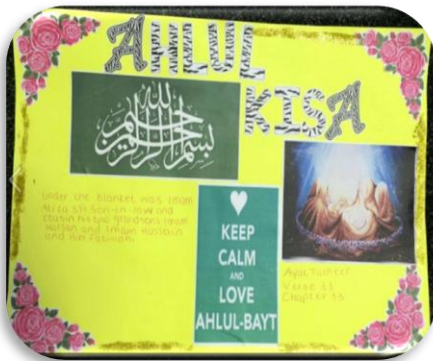


## IMAM Madrasah Seminar: Wilayah
